What is a 1099 G/INT?

- A 1099 G/INT is a tax document that you may need to reference when filing your Individual Income Tax return. It shows the amount of refund, credit, or interest you received during 2020 for the tax years listed in Box 3.
- **The total in Box 1 includes any portion that was refunded, applied to any outstanding debt, transferred to Estimated Tax, sent to any of the contribution check-off funds, or applied as a Use Tax payment**
- You do not need to report this amount as income if, during the year you paid the tax, you either:
 1. claimed the standard deduction OR
 2. elected to deduct state and local sales taxes instead of state and local Income Taxes.

What each box means:

- **Box 1:** Includes tax amounts refunded, credited to Estimated Tax, applied to a prior year balance due, contributed to a fund, applied to South Carolina Use Tax, or paid to the IRS or other state agency. Use the State and Local Income Tax refund worksheet in the federal 1040 instructions to determine if any of your refund is taxable. Enter the taxable amount on Schedule 1, line 1, of your federal form 1040. For South Carolina purposes, subtract the total on line f of the SC1040. The amount reported in Box 1 may include overpayments received by you this year for multiple tax years.
- **Box 2:** Amount of interest paid on tax refunds. This amount should be reported on your federal return.
- **Box 3:** Indicates the tax years for the refund in Box 1.
