Because you and/or members of your household had Health Insurance Marketplace coverage for all or some part of 2020, we're required to provide you with the enclosed "Form 1095-A, Health Insurance Marketplace Statement." You must file a tax return

You must file a federal income tax return if you or another member of your household received any advance payments of the premium tax credit in 2020 to lower premium costs, even if you don't normally file a return. If advance payments are made on behalf of you or an individual in your family and you don't file a tax return, you won't be eligible for advance payments of the premium tax credit or cost-sharing reductions to help pay for your Marketplace health coverage in future years.

When you file your tax return electronically or by mail, you must complete and file "Form 8962, Premium Tax Credit." Use the information on the included Form 1095-A to complete Form 8962. The Form 1095-A also indicates which months of 2020 you and other members of your household had health coverage. You'll need that information to complete your tax return. 
