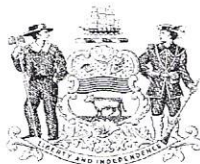

The amount of the refund must typically be included in taxable income on a federal return for the year of receipt if the taxpayer itemized deductions for federal purposes in the year to which the refund relates and the amount of the refund was included as part of the taxpayer's itemized deductions. COMBINED 1099G AND FILING REQUIREMENT NOTIFICATION

The form 1099-G set forth above indicates the total refunds, credits, or offsets of state income tax you received from the State of Delaware. This amount may be taxable to you if you included state income taxes paid as part of your itemized deductions on your Federal income tax return. This may be true even if you did not receive a refund payment for the amount shown (e.g., because you applied the refund to your 2021 Delaware estimated taxes or if it was set off and applied to satisfy another debt).

Please note that only the last four digits of your social security number (SSN) are displayed on this document to enhance security and confidentiality. Please confirm the last four digits displayed above match the last four digits of your full social security number.

For faster refunds and greater accuracy, we encourage you to file electronically. Electronic filing is available through your tax preparer, commercial tax software, or via our website (click on "File Personal Income Tax" below "Tax Services & Information"). Once you have filed your return, you may check the status of a pending refund by visiting our website at revenue.delaware.gov (click on "Check Return Status" below "Where is my refund?").

To minimize printing and mailing costs, the Delaware Division of Revenue will mail personal income tax booklets only to those who filed a paper return in the prior tax year. If you require forms and/or instructions, please visit our website at revenue.delaware.gov. Otherwise, they are available at libraries throughout the State and at our Public Service Offices located in Wilmington, Dover, and Georgetown.
