Before we can process your Form 2553, we need the following information:

We need consent statements from all shareholders. For each shareholder, include:

- Shareholder's signature

To be considered timely filed, your Form 2553 must be filed within two months and 15 days from the date you request your election to be effective.

You can resubmit your Form 2553 with verification that you filed your form on time. Your verification can be a copy of Form 2553 with an IRS date-of-receipt stamp, a copy of your Notice of Acceptance, or a certified mail receipt.

If you didn't file Form 2553 on time, you can request relief under Revenue Procedure 2013-30. Generally, to request relief for a late S corporation election, file the following documents with the service center where you filed your Form 2553:

1. A properly completed Form 2553 with the words, "FILED PURSUANT TO REV. PROC. 2013-30," written on the top of the form. An officer of the corporation authorized to sign and all persons who were shareholders at any time must sign the Form 2553.
2. A statement explaining your reasonable cause for failing to file Form 2553 by the original due date of the election and the diligent actions you took to correct the mistake upon its discovery.
