New for 2022 Tax Year - Where applicable, 1099 Tax Forms for Robinhood Securities, Robinhood Crypto, and Robinhood Money are being consolidated into one package and reported under our parent entity, Robinhood Markets Inc. We have done this to ensure all forms that you need are provided at the same time in this consolidated package.

Important - Please utilize the Master Account Number and Document ID listed above if filing through tax service providers such as TurboTax or H&R Block. The Document ID is necessary in order to directly import your 1099 data into the tax software so that you do not need to manually enter each transaction. This year there is only one Master Account Number and Document ID that needs to be used to import all of your data across all accounts and 1099s (including crypto). Please note that tax software providers may have limits on the total number of transactions that can be directly imported using the Document ID.

CSVs - In addition, a CSV file which includes the same information that is reported on your 1099 forms will be provided. The CSV is not a separate 1099. It is being provided as a supplement in a format that may be more helpful if you have a large number of transactions or if you are not using the Document ID to import all of your Securities, Crypto and Money activity. Tax software providers may have limits on the total number of transactions that can be uploaded and CSV files may not be compatible with tax service providers such as TurboTax or H&R Block.

Robinhood Retirements Accounts - If you had any reportable distributions or contributions within a Robinhood Retirement account, your 2022 tax forms 1099-R and/or 5498 will be delivered separately. Retirement accounts will be reported under Robinhood Securities LLC and will have their own unique Doc IDs for import to tax software providers such as TurboTax or H&R Block.
