

Paper Filing Instructions for applying ITIN for Spouse

Steps to be followed –

1. Download the Attached PDF Federal tax documents
2. Print them on ONE side page only and **DO NOT STAPLE** them.
3. You and Your Spouse have to sign on Form 1040 page 2. **See below image**

4. Attach Form W7 (ITIN Application) & your Spouse has to Sign it. **See below image**

5. Attach a copy of all W2's of the year 2023.
6. You and your spouse need to sign on Form 6013(G).
7. Schedule an Appoint with IRS on **844-545-5640**
8. Visit IRS Office along with your Spouse and Original Passport, IRS office address is provided in the Email.
