Kids Meal project has restarted its activities in the Temple. Kids Vikas has to date made over 70,000 meal packets with Kids Meals Organization being the beneficiary to serve children in need and conducts its activity in the temple on a weekly basis.

Another recent development at Sri Ashtalakshmi Temple is a volunteer run kitchen called Saatvik Bhog. The kitchen serves "Saatvik" food that can be purchased, and all proceeds go to the Temple's causes. The Temple is also working on a plan for a full kitchen renovation that will increase its scope of service.

In addition to every Friday evening Sri Mahalakshmi Abhishekam, Saturday morning Vishesha Poojas, temple is continuing to conduct weekly yoga classes, Bhagavatha Kalakshepam on Sunday mornings, Bhagavad Gita chanting on Sundays afternoon. Temple also has a Library / Store.

Prajna Vedic classes for students in both ALT and Katy locations have been conducting classes with great fervor. Many children who had started out in Prajna as elementary schoolers have now graduated from high school with honors and have secured places in prestigious universities. They routinely attribute their success to the values they learned in Prajna, and some have returned as teachers to give back what they received.

VT Seva, the service wing of Sri Chinna Jeeyar Swamiji's organization has been



actively conducting its activities in the Greater Houston area and also has been supporting schools for blind and tribal children in India. The Houston chapter of VT Seva works very closely with the temple.


